Scheme of Learning Title:	Exam Focus
Key Learning:	<p>Students will complete a range of revision tasks that will cover everything that the students have covered over year 7, 8 and 9. Students will cover a range of areas to ensure they understand the keywords, give definitions and answer in essay style responses.</p> <p>Students will attempt a variety of exam style questions and will complete a mock test in the run up to their exam.</p>
Assessment:	Students will be given a formal online assessment at the end of the project which will include multiple choice questions, scenarios and comparisons at the end of the scheme of learning. Students will be assessed throughout the project, through marking, peer assessment and self-assessment.
Key Words:	<p><b>Construct</b> – to make or create (something, such as a story or theory) by organising ideas, words, etc.</p> <p><b>Explain</b> – to tell, show, or be the reason for or cause of something</p> <p><b>Compare</b> – Examine and note the similarities or differences</p> <p><b>Convert</b> – to change (something) into a different form or so that it can be used in a different way</p>
